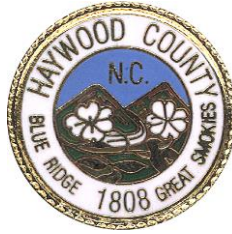


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## **Legal Notice**

### **Announcement of a Public Meeting and Comment Period**

#### **Francis Farm Landfill (Permit #44-03)**

Described as:

Francis Farm Landfill, Farmview Drive, Haywood County, North Carolina.

The North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has reviewed an Assessment of Corrective Measures (ACM) report dated March 16, 2017 prepared by Bunnell-Lammons Engineering, Inc. (BLE) for the subject site. The ACM report was prepared as required in general accordance with the North Carolina Rules for Solid Waste Management. The DEQ has determined that this site needs corrective action and has required the Haywood County to complete the selection of remedy process and to submit to a corrective action plan (CAP) for environmental compliance. Before the selection of remedy can be completed and a CAP can be written and submitted to the DEQ, the public has the opportunity to review ACM report and provide comments to the DEQ and to Haywood County about the document.
