

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

CONCERNING PROPOSED HIGH IMPACT DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE
PURSUANT TO NCGS 153A-121 and 153A-320

TAKE NOTICE that the Haywood County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 15, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. in the Historic Courtroom of the Haywood County Historic Courthouse located at 215 N. Main Street, Waynesville, NC 28786. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the proposed County of Haywood, North Carolina Code of Ordinances, Title XV, Chapter 160, County High Impact Development Ordinance.

Copies of the proposed ordinance can be viewed on the Haywood County website prior to the public hearing and copies can be obtained at the County Manager's Office or at the public hearing. The proposed ordinance will not be enacted before September 6, 2016.

Persons wishing to be heard at the public hearing are asked to be present. The County Commissioners may adopt reasonable rules governing the conduct of the hearing including (i) fixing the maximum time allotted to each speaker, (ii) providing for the designation of spokesmen for groups of persons supporting or opposing the same position, (iii) providing for the selection of delegates from groups of persons supporting or opposing the same positions when the number of persons wishing to attend the hearing exceeds the capacity of the hall, and (iv) providing for the maintenance of order and decorum in the conduct of the hearing.
