Resolution in Opposition to NC Joint Legislative Evaluation Oversight Committee 2011 Recommendation to Merge Community Colleges

Whereas, the Haywood County Board of Commissioners recognizes the significance of Haywood Community College in fostering and stabilizing Haywood County economic, workforce, and community development; and

Whereas, Haywood Community College provides leadership critical to the sustaining viable higher education; and

Whereas, Haywood County has duly supported Haywood Community College with local funding since its inception in 1965; and

Therefore, the Haywood County Board of Commissioners with this resolution firmly opposes the recommendation put forth by the NC General Assembly Joint Legislative Program Evaluation Committee on July 13, 2011 to reduce the number of small colleges (those with less than 3,000 full-time equivalents) through administrative mergers.
