- 60 FGP volunteers serving around 60,000 hours a year
- Volunteers receive a tax free hourly stipend, mileage reimbursements, leave, insurance, recognition, etc.
- Annual volunteer impact approx. 1 million dollars

Make Independence a Reality



- Senior volunteers helping other seniors maintain their independence
- 55 SCP volunteers serving over 65,000 hours this year valued at over 1.1 million dollars of volunteer impact
- Volunteers receive a tax free hourly stipend, mileage reimbursements, leave, insurance, recognition, etc.

Congregate Nutrition Program


- Canton Senior Center,

In-Home Level 1 Chore Program



- Assists senior adults with home
management tasks to help them remain
living independently

- Cleaning, cooking, shopping, errands for
groceries, medications, etc.

- Approximately 3800 hours served to 75
seniors each year.

- Waiting list maintained year round

- Senior Volunteers serving non-profit agencies

- Approx. 120 volunteers serving 25,000 hours each year

- Volunteers receive limited mileage reimbursements and supplemental insurance

- Volunteer impact over \$400,000

- Links volunteers to organizations in Haywood County

 - *198 active volunteer & 66 agencies

- Senior Wood Project - 74 loads last year

- 4-5 fundraising events each year

Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP)



- Non biased counseling for Medicare beneficiaries

- Helps with Part D plans, Advantage Plans, Long-Term Care Insurance, etc.

- Served 373 Medicare beneficiaries last year and saved them \$192,144

Phone Assurance Program


- Daily phone call to isolated seniors.

- Checks that they are okay and do not need anything

- Phone calls are placed by Senior Leadership volunteers

An intake worker is available to help individuals apply for services and programs offered through Mountain Projects, Inc.


CAREGIVER RESPITE TRAINING AND LIST

- Public Safety Program designed to quickly locate missing persons due to wandering

- Partnership with Haywood County Sheriff's Office.



- Batteries are replaced by Senior Resource Teams at the Senior Resource Center each month

- Treats individuals with memory loss and dementia to increase their quality of life while also offering training, counseling, and support to family members.


