Expanded Information on Reasons Why You Would Like to serve on this Board

As our area grows and its population ages, the role a strong HCC can have in equipping and transforming a workforce to serve our community as well as prepare persons for further academic endeavor becomes all the more clear and crucial. As the college seeks to address challenges in a creative and effective manner, I understand the role of a board member should be to help maintain the desired values and culture of the institution, to evaluate and guide progress toward stated goals, and to assist in facilitating communication between the college and the community that it seeks to serve.

I feel that my training, work experiences, and community involvement, as well as a long time commitment to the community college concept, equip me to assist Haywood Community College in continuing a respected and expanding service to the people of Haywood County and beyond.

My experience with a two-year public college that also provided quality technical training began as a high school student on the shared campus of a junior college in Ellisville, MS. Jones County Junior College and Agricultural High School offered opportunities to complete two-years of high school, two-years of college, and varied lengths of technical training. A variety of students, including a number receiving GI Bill support, was engaged in the first stages of college work while others sought certified training in ongoing and emerging skills. A large number of students were from rural communities and many went on to become effective craftsmen and professional leaders in the area.

Several years ago, my wife and I endowed a scholarship at JCJC in honor of my parents. Over time, some of "our" students pursued additional college study. Many others worked toward or completed certification in health care, computer sciences, business services and other disciplines. No small number were later-in-life students seeking a viable career and might well have missed their opportunity to succeed without the College's programs. Some years ago, the high school segment of the program was discontinued and today the Junior College (read community college) has an enrollment exceeding 5,000 participants.

My wife, Dianne, a retired guidance counselor from Haywood County Schools, earlier was part of the small core staff that helped launch Roane County (TN) Community College which now enrolls over 6,000 students on several campuses. The Dean of Faculty and Dean of Students were members of a congregation I served. Through conversations and experiences, I became even more aware of the important role community colleges can have in service to diverse communities. Later, when the first satellite campus was established in Oak Ridge, the facilities of the church I served were used as a setting for classes and other activities.

Each instance expanded my appreciation for the value of effective community colleges. Later I served for ten years on the Board of Hiwassee College which provided a similar ministry in Madisonville, TN. I was able to engage students with varied backgrounds who chose continued college work or skill training as appropriate for them as well as with faculty members possessing unique perspectives and inspiring senses of mission.

Soon after arriving in Haywood County, Dianne and I completed continuing education classes in computer science at HCC. Later, as Lake Junaluska Assembly worked through a Quality Improvement emphasis that sought to enhance employees' skills, HCC provided GED and other literacy helps as well as helpful skill development opportunities for our team members. I will never forget how the staff of Lake Junaluska Assembly and SEJAC joyfully shared the excitement at individual workers' "graduations".

All of this strengthened my hope that HCC will help continue their successes with ever more relevant and creative programs. With this personal experience base and gratitude for support I and others have received from so many across the years, I would be honored to serve as a member of the Board of Trustees of Haywood Community College, help the institution address the future, and assist the college in fulfilling its purpose.

After retiring from Deloitte, I have worked 6 months a year as a Special Associate Director for the PCAOB, a division of the SEC in Washington, DC


