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ORDINANCE ADOPTING SCHEDULES, STANDARDS, AND RULES
TO BE USED IN APPRAISING REAL PROPERTY FOR THE 2017 GENERAL REAPPRAISAL

- WHEREAS, North Carolina law requires all real property be appraised at least every eight years, and this Board has advanced the scheduled Octennial Reappraisal to be effective as of January 1, 2017;
- WHEREAS, the County Assessor submitted the proposed Schedules, Standards, and Rules to be used in appraising real property for the 2017 general reappraisal of real property at its true value and at its present-use value to the Haywood County Board of Commissioners and State of North Carolina;
- WHEREAS, a notice was published on September 7, 2016 advising that the proposed Schedules, Standards, and Rules had been presented to the Board and that the same had been made available for public inspection, and further declaring that the Board would hold a public hearing at a regular meeting of the Board beginning at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, September 19, 2016, in the Historic Courtroom of the Haywood County Courthouse located at 215 North Main Street, Waynesville, North Carolina, on the proposed Schedules, Standards, and Rules;
- WHEREAS, the aforesaid public hearing was conducted at the Board's September 19, 2016 regular meeting;
- WHEREAS, the matter of the final approval of the proposed Schedules, Standards, and Rules having come before this Board at its regular meeting on this the 3rd day of October 2016 and having reviewed and discussed the Schedules, Standards, and Rules with the County Assessor, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of Haywood County to adopt the Schedules, Standards, and Rules to be used in appraising all real property for the 2017 general reappraisal;
- WHEREAS, it appearing that the Schedules, Standards and Rules for the 2017 Octennial Reappraisal has been prepared in conformance with the requirements of GS 105-317; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Haywood County Board of commissioners as follows:

1. That the Schedules, Standards, and Rules to be used in appraising all real property for the 2017 general reappraisal of real property at its true value and at its present-use value be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.
2. That the Schedules, Standards, and Rules are open for examination in the County Tax Assessor's office and the County Manager's office located at 215 North Main Street, Waynesville, North Carolina.

3. That the Clerk to the Board shall cause notice of this order to be published once a week for four successive weeks, with the last publication being not less than seven days before the last day for challenging the validity of the Schedules, Standards, and Rules by appeal to the Property Tax Commission.
4. That the administration of the real and personal property tax appraisal shall at all times be in compliance with the provisions of Article 19, Chapter 105 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
